

Public Notice

The City of Modesto is providing notice and requesting public comment regarding a proposed application to impose and use a Passenger Facility Charge (PFC) at the Modesto City-County Airport – Harry Sham Field (MOD). The PFCs will also be used in support of administering the PFC program for the City. Key points of the new PFC are as follows:

Overview of the New PFC:

Proposed Charge Effective Date:	December 1, 2012
Proposed Total PFC Impose and Use:	\$ 273,845
Estimated Charge Expiration Date:	December 1, 2015
Proposed PFC Charge Level	\$ 4.50

Description of Projects:

1 - Apron Rehabilitation

This project is phase-II of slurry seal work completed on our west asphalt ramp. Phase-I, near the general aviation hangars, was completed in 2006. Approximately 900,000 sq. ft. of asphalt ramp will receive crack repair, slurry seal and re-paint mark work. This project is necessary in order to preserve this asphalt ramp surface.

2 - Enhance Runway Safety Area

As the result of a 2007 FAA Runway Safety Action Team inspection, the airport pursued the reconfiguration of taxiway access to the threshold of RW10R from TW-B. This project included the construction of a new access TW, closure of the unsafe access TW route and development of a new RW blast-pad.
